- 3. Go on a ramble or nature walk with a purpose. Take a walk up to **Beacon Fell** or along the **River Brock**. Go hunting for mini-beasts around Waddecar, from the **Dipping Pond** at Bills meadow, across the **fields**, through the **woods** and splash in the river.
- 4. Learn the Green Cross Code and show that you can cross a road safely. The tracks at Waddecar can easily be used to practise, and roads and junctions can be marked out on the ground with ropes. Once you have practised in a traffic free environment you can remember what you have learnt on the walk to Beacon Fell!
